Rules and Regulations

Students seeking admission in the college are bound to observe the following rules and regulations. Therefore before taking the admission, both students and parents are requested to read them carefully-

1. The candidate will be interviewed, at the time of admission, Therefore it is a prerequisite that the student should be present personally.
2. Students seeking admission should submit all the testimonials along with 3 passport size photos for office work.
3. Fee once deposited will not be refunded.
4. Change of subject or stream is not allowed once the admission is taken.
5. Student having less than 75% attendance will not be allowed to appear in the examination.
6. College bus facility is available from Tilda-Neora to college for all students and fees will be charged for it accordingly.
7. Students should bring their identity cards regularly. If it is lost, they will have to apply for another copy.
8. Students are requested to take utmost care of the properties of the college and its cleanliness. Any student who is found damaging them will be liable for punishment.
9. Library books are to be handled with care, if a student is found causing damage to the books he or she will be fined Rs.10 along with the cost of the book. Such students will not be eligible for using library books further. Further if the books are not returned within the prescribed time, fine will be imposed on each book on per day basis.
10. Name of the student will be struck off from the register of the college if he or she is absent for one month without prior permission of the Principal. University does not consider medical certificate for the attendance purpose, but for the college record it has to be produced.
11. Girls should wear only SALWAR SUIT (With Chunari) and Boys should wear TROUSER & SHIRT in the college campus.
12. Students should secure written permission from their parents for attending camps, study tour, or any other training programmes.
13. Student will be expelled from the college if he/she is found guilty of any indiscipline.
14. Age limit for admission as regular students for graduation is 25 years. It will be counted from 1st July onwards.
15. Mobile phones, Walkman or any other such instrument is strictly forbidden in the college premises.
16. Ragging is strictly prohibited in the college campus and if a student is found guilty, necessary disciplinary action would be taken against him/her.
17. If a student has any problem he or she can contact the Principal directly. The college will solve the problem within its norms.

Century Cement College — Admission Guidelines

1. Application and Admission Process

- **Online Application:** Applications for admission must be submitted "**Online**" through the university-level portal. Applications received from the university will be forwarded to the respective colleges. Admission will then be granted at the college level by the Principal based on merit and admission rules.
- **Verification of Original Documents:** The admission committee will permit the payment of admission fees only after verifying and matching the copies of the attached certificates with the **original documents** and receiving the original Transfer Certificate (TC).
- **Transfer Certificate (TC):** Admission will not be granted on the basis of a duplicate copy of the Transfer Certificate. In case a TC is lost, admission can only be considered upon producing a police FIR report, an official report from the previous institution mentioning the TC serial number and date, and an undertaking from the student. Immediately after granting admission, the TC must be cancelled with an "Admission Granted" stamp.
- **Fee Payment:** The admission to the college will be considered valid only after the prescribed fees are deposited.

2. Important Dates for Admission

- **Regular Admission Period:** For the first semester of undergraduate courses and other classes/semesters, the admission process will be conducted by the Principal from **June 16 to July 31, 2026**.
- **Admission with Vice-Chancellor's Permission:** If seats remain vacant, admission can be granted with a late fee of ₹100 until **August 14, 2026**, subject to the permission of the Vice-Chancellor of Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University. No admissions will be permitted after this date.
- **Delayed Results:** In case examination results are declared late, the admission process must be completed within **10 working days** from the date of the declaration of the results.

3. Academic Eligibility Criteria

- **B.Com/ BCA (First Semester UG):** Applicants must have passed the 10+2 (Intermediate) examination.
- **M.Com (First Semester PG):** Applicants must have passed the Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com) graduation examination to be eligible for regular admission.
- **PGDCA (First Semester PG):** Applicants must have passed the Under graduation examination in any stream to be eligible for regular admission.
- **Faculty/Stream Change:** If an applicant seeks admission by changing their faculty, subject, or group from their qualifying examination, their merit position will be determined by **deducting 5 percent marks** from their actual obtained marks. Any weightage will be calculated on these reduced marks.

4. Reservation Rules

As per the reservation policy of the Government of Chhattisgarh, seat reservation across all branches of study or faculties will be implemented vertically and horizontally as follows:

- **Scheduled Tribes (ST):** 32% of the annual sanctioned seats are reserved.
- **Scheduled Castes (SC):** 12% of the annual sanctioned seats are reserved.
- **Other Backward Classes (OBC):** 14% of the annual sanctioned seats are reserved (excluding the creamy layer).
- **Reservation for Female Candidates (Horizontal):** Out of the available seats in all categories, **30% of the seats are reserved for female students.**
- **Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan):** **5% of the seats** are reserved for applicants under the disabled category.
- **Freedom Fighters:** **3% of the seats** are reserved for the sons, daughters, grandsons, granddaughters, and maternal grandchildren of freedom fighters.

5. Merit Determination and Weightage

If the number of applicants exceeds the available seats, admission will be strictly based on merit (marks obtained in the qualifying exam + applicable weightage). Weightage is granted only for merit determination and cannot be used to achieve minimum eligibility.

- **N.C.C. / N.S.S. / Scouts and Guides:**
 - **2 percent** weightage for N.S.S./N.C.C. "A" Certificate holders.
 - **3 percent** weightage for N.S.S./N.C.C. "B" Certificate or Second Sopan passed Scouts/Guides.
 - **4 percent** weightage for "C" Certificate or Third Sopan passed Scouts/Guides.
 - **5 percent** weightage for students who participated in the Republic Day (RD) Parade in New Delhi as part of the Chhattisgarh N.C.C./N.S.S. contingent.
- **Sports / Cultural / Literary Competitions:** Students securing 1st, 2nd, or 3rd positions, or representing their division/state in tournaments organized by the Directorate of Public Instruction, Department of Higher Education C.G., or the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) are eligible for weightage ranging from **2% to 15%** under prescribed rules.
- **Note:** All certificates supporting a claim for weightage must be attached along with the admission application form; certificates submitted later will not be considered.

6. Other Important Rules and Discipline

- **Removal of Age Limit:** According to the directives of the Higher Education Department, Government of C.G., the **age limit restriction has been completely removed** for admission to all classes and courses.
- **Government/Private Employees:** Regular employees of full-time government or private organizations are not eligible for regular admission during their daily duty hours. If attending college outside duty hours, they must submit a **No Objection Certificate (NOC)** from their employer before admission can be granted.
- **Indiscipline and Ragging:** The Principal is authorized to deny admission to applicants against whom a charge sheet has been filed in court, criminal cases are pending, or who are accused of serious misconduct, ragging, or damaging institutional property.
- **Cancellation of Admission due to Absence:** If a student, after taking admission, remains continuously absent for **one month or more** without prior permission or proper justification, the Principal has the authority to cancel their admission.
- **Refund of Fees:** If a student leaves the college, has their admission cancelled, or is expelled during the session, **no fees will be refunded** except for the caution money (caution deposit).
